PETER SUART was raised in Hong Kong and schooled in England. In 1985 he returned to Hong Kong to work as an artist, musician, writer and theatrical performer. Since 1999 he has lived in England. He is a keen sportsman.

### **BOOKS**

Suart is the author and illustrator of the Tik and Tok books, for children and adults, published by MCCM Creations in Hong Kong. These comprise Where is The World?, The Storm, The Love of Learning, The Secret of the Universe, Sirens, Smoke, North and a comic book, The Black Book of Falling. He illustrates for The Folio Society in London; recent titles include Robertson Davies' The Deptford Trilogy, Mikhail Bulgakov's The Master and Margarita and Nikolai Gogol's Collected Stories.

#### MUSIC

Suart is co-founder, with Kung Chi Shing, of 'the box', a theatrical music ensemble. Since 1987 they have made concerts and music theatre works, collaborating with dancers, actors and artists. Their latest piece, the box, side 14 — bluebeard, was performed in Hong Kong in 2007. They have released three albums.

Suart works solo in the same capacity and has released six albums. He has performed in Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan, China, Japan, Norway, Finland, Cuba, America and the UK. He is currently performing with Joymask, an English band.

### **THEATRE**

Suart has written and performed four one-man plays (on the Holy Grail, the Holocaust, Quantum Mechanics, and Race Relations in Hong Kong) and has designed sets, narrated and acted for theatre and dance companies in Hong Kong and Taiwan.

### **TALKS**

Suart has given talks for children and adults on many subjects, including The History of the Illustrated Book (HK Arts Centre 2001), The Illustrated Shakespeare (British Council in HK 2002), The Love of Reading (HK Literary Festival 2002), Tom Waits and Irony (HK Arts Festival 1999), and Pictures and Text (Bedales School UK 2003).
